
## The Fall Feasts of Israel; their Meaning, their Purpose and their Final Fulfillment.

## The Fall Feasts of Israel; their Meaning, their Purpose and their Final Fulfillment.


Before we focus on the *Fall Feasts* lets take a quick look at all seven feasts. These are the **the holy** convocations, the moeds, the feasts of the Lord, of the Lord. His name, according to some of the Karaite Jews, is Ye-ho-vah', He is the Almighty and Everlasting One, the God of Israel, AND the God of the Christian Church or the *Congregation of Messiah*. These holidays are celebrations and rehearsals of seven divinely appointed events. Four of them have already broken out into holy history in times past. The remaining three of them will erupt into their monumental fulfillments in times to come.




The Bible was never intended to be obtuse or complicated. The prophet Habakkuk was told to "write the vision" he was given of the latter days and to "make it plain and simple on tablets." In Habakkuk chapter two God sends a stern warning to those who seek dominion by craft and disinformation and to the false teachers who will rise up in the latter days and confuse the plain meaning of His Holy Word.

Habakkuk 2 <sup>2</sup> And the LORD answered me, and said, "Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. <sup>3</sup> For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak . . . . . : though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come ..."



God brings us a host of prophetic messages from the **Old Testament** as well as the New. In 1Corinthians 10 our Apostle Paul says, "Now these things happened to them as examples for us to take note of, shadows of things to come. They were written down for our admonition. They are instructive warnings for us, the people for whom the ends of the earth, or the culmination of the ages, has come." - 1Cor. 10:11 – (GWF expanded)


The seven feasts were ordained by God and received by Moses at Sinai. They have been celebrated and rehearsed, (after a fashion), ever since those former times.



So are the feasts just annual festivals of a bygone era? Are they to be regarded by Christian believers as just ancient Jewish lore and ritual? The Bible calls them the Feasts of the Lord. So can we really say that they irrelevant? No . . . Not at all.



God ordained the feasts for *all* His Elect. This includes the royal Jewish House of Judah to be sure. But the other house, the wild, lost, and amnesic House of Ephraim in the West is not to be forgotten. This company of people now sets the global agenda and carries the main bulk of believers in our Hebrew Messiah. Yes, the Ephraim that was divorced from Israel and declared by God "not my people" is now coming back. Through the **New Covenant** they are being grafted back into the olive tree of Israel.



As we see in Isaiah 49:6 and in many other scriptures God's Servant was prophesied to be a Light to the heathen, the nations, the Gentiles.

The infant Jesus was presented at the Temple. The priest Simeon announced that the child grow up to be the promised Light for revelation to the Gentiles and to His people Israel.



"Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel."

Today, nearly 2,000 later, the Light to the Gentiles is shining out to the ends of the earth. And how is that happening?



For God, who commanded the Light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

II Corinthians 4:6

The Light of Israel, is shed abroad through the Gospel. Even now, our Savior and Redeemer is indwelling, ministering, and ruling in human hearts.



Our Apostle Paul tells us in Ephesians 2:12-13 that the through the blood of Christ our Messiah, (and not the DNA bloodlines in which it may flow), the Gentiles, formerly strangers to the covenants of promise, will join the adoption into the citizenship or Commonwealth of Israel.



So the feasts are signposts on a roadmap. They are provided for ALL of those who are apprehended by that Light to the nations. The Fall Feasts are a special blessing for us, if we can just see it. They were given to us as a timepiece to document and to track the unfolding of God's agenda here below. This is important. Because our journey will take us on into some awesome future times, and right up to the midnight hour.



All of us have a sure and certain divine appointment with our Messiah. A search through the Holy Scriptures of such phrases as "appointed time", "set time", or "that Day" points to the climax of the age when Messiah will return at the time of the harvest. We'll talk about that later in this video.



But typically Christians will say, "What's this **Seven Feast** business? Hey, this is **Old** Testament Jewish stuff isn't it? And you say "written down for our admonition. Really? Hey, we are the Church! We are different from Israel. We have an entirely separate deal. And you say that I am one of those persons for whom the ends of this age, will come? Who me?"




Ever since the Day of Pentecost God has been at work by His Holy Spirit. And as we read Isaiah 49:6 it seems that our Messiah has a big all encompassing agenda. The Light of Israel is going out to the ends of the earth. The fullness of the heathen Gentiles is being brought in. And just as He promised, our Messiah is multiplying the nation of Israel.

And he said, "It is too small a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved



ones of Israel: I will also give you for a light to the Gentiles, that you may be my salvation unto the ends of the earth." Isa. 49:6

In the *Olivet Discourse* our Messiah promised that He will re-gather **ALL** His covenant people as a single undivided Elect. He asked His prophet Ezekiel to do a show and tell for us on this reunion just so we'd get the message. It's there in Ezekiel 37. The two sticks are destined to become one. Joseph's dream was that all his brothers would bow down to him. And in Genesis 49 Jacob declared to his son Judah that **Shiloh would come**, and unto Him shall the gathering of the people be. In the dual office of the Order of Melchizedek both of these prophecies are will be fulfilled to restore Israel as a single undivided royal priesthood and a holy nation.



Our God is calling the shots here. He created the cosmos and as He sits upon His throne above the heavens He is sovereign across space and time. He has the whole world is in His hands. And during the final seven years of this age He is The One who oversees the unfolding of His agenda. He sets the limits of the raging of the nations. He is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. And He is the Author and the Finisher of our faith.



At the set times of the feasts God is showing us that **Newtonian time and space**, this whole cosmos, is His. All of holy history, past and future, from here to eternity was written down by Him before the foundation of the world. And on the coming Day of the Lord all this is to be revealed. On that Day a portal will open between heaven and earth to reveal the unseen eternal realms beyond.

Holy History unfolds according to God's over-arching plan. He officiates over the end-time from His courts above. In Daniel 7 we see that the Ancient of Days is presiding in judgment over events as they unfold during the Great Tribulation.





A stream of fire issued and came out from before him; a thousand thousands served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him; the court sat in judgment, and the books were opened.

John saw the unfolding court case as well and described it in Revelation 4. A Judge, Christ our Messiah, will preside over His own revelation in holy history. He will oversee it all and set the limits on events as the epic saga unfolds here below.

4 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, "Come up hither, and *I will shew thee things which must be hereafter*." <sup>2</sup> And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, *a throne was set in heaven*, and *one sat on the throne*. <sup>3</sup> And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.











So here are the three Spring feasts over on the left. They are Passover, Unleavened Bread, and Firstfruits. They were fulfilled 2,000 years ago; And precisely on the dates to which they belonged. And just how were those Spring Feasts fulfilled? Well. In some very Christian ways.



Briefly stated, they were fulfilled in the death, burial, and Resurrection of Jesus. These three pivotal events erupted into holy history precisely on the very Hebrew calendar feast dates to which they belonged.


The three Fall Feasts are over on the right. Our Jewish friends have remembered these Holy Days for us. Thank God they did. And may God bless them for this. Because we sure didn't. And we are not remembering them now. We are a forgetful people. These are dates on the Hebrew calendar in which certain epic events are yet to occur. The three Fall Feasts are sitting there waiting for us to look into them. Each *holiday* awaits the appointed time, and the day that will witness their final fulfillment.



In this video we'll focus on the first two of those Fall Feasts. What is the spirit and character of each one? Let's study them. Let's ask God to explain to us their deeper meaning. How are they celebrated today? And how is their future fulfillment being rehearsed? Just what will God be doing when each divine appointment is fulfilled in times to come? And let's not forget to ask this question. Why will He be doing it?




So let's consider the Fall Feasts, the first one being the Feast of Trumpets. The more Biblically based name from Leviticus 23:24, 25 is Yome Teruah.




And if we put an "e" at the end of the word Yom we'll be prompted to pronounce it right. It is pronounced Yome Teruah

# Yom Teruah - pronounced Yome Teruah.

After Yom Teruah comes the Day of Atonement. Our Jewish friends call it **Yome Kippur** from the Hebrew word "kapparah" which means to cover or to protect.



It is now becoming quite apparent that these two Fall Feasts are very important. In a time future and right on these Hebrew calendar dates God's covenant people will find themselves facing world events of Biblical proportions. Those who sincerely seek the face of God are now beginning to study these feasts and to face up to the issues they present faithfully and responsibly.



Here's a simple question.
Will these **seven** divine appointments continue to unfold in the sequence God has laid out in Leviticus 23?

If we look at what has happened so far we can be sure that they will.



In a previous video entitled, "The Fall Feasts and the Timeline of the Final 7 Years of this Age" we saw that the Feast of Trumpets, (aka Yom Teruah), and the Day of Atonement (or Yom Kippur), appear to be bookends staking out the final seven years of this age. There is a precisely fitted **2550** day timeline here. It encompasses the 70th Week of Daniel and goes on to terminate on the Day of Atonement which in turn, ushers in the Day of the Lord.

The first two Fall Feasts are yet to be fulfilled.

They will encompass the 70<sup>th</sup> Week of Daniel and initiate and terminate the final seven years of this age.

The inclusive Timeline bridging the Fall Feasts is also precisely 2550 DAYS!


As we have seen in our earlier study, most of the future seven year timelines that bridge the Fall Feasts across seven years, (timeline's that embrace 86 moons and not 87 moons), are time periods of 2550 days. This is the exact day-count for the final 7 years of this age.

Some upcoming inclusive day counts between Trumpets and Atonement for some future seven year time spans.



Now we go on to address the main purpose of this video and ask this question. What is the *spirit, nature, and* purpose of these two upcoming appointed times? By what events and in what manner will they come into their divine fulfillments? (Ken Burns effect)



Christian and Messianic believers are now beginning to realize that the *Fall Feasts* must see their ultimate fulfillment in two highly significant future events. These two feasts **should** be the object of diligent inquiry. But alas, this is not happening. Many great truths about the latter days are still hidden from us. Our dear Messianic rabbis still insist on keeping the Fall Feasts cloaked in Jewish tradition. And our Christian churchmen are either ignoring the feasts or hijacking them to support their popular pet doctrines.




So let's start with this. Does **Yom Teruah** fit the spirit and character of the *Resurrection-Rapture?* Does the broken noted *Teruah* shofar blast exhibit the note of closure we might expect to hear at the *Last Trump*? Let's examine the evidence and look more carefully into this matter. Because the **Yom Teruah** rehearsed in the Jewish house ushers us into a season of repentance known as the Days of Awe. A trumpet call to assembly in repentance is one thing. And a trumpet blast proclaiming the grand finale of the age, the final glorification, the *Resurrection-Rapture* of the Elect, is quite another. These events would seem to call for quite distinct and different shofar sounds. Which shofar blast fits and matches which occasion? Let's look into this matter.




The inclusive Timeline bridging those Fall Feasts is precisely 2550 DAYS!

Motivational speaking with what is called a "positive" or "upbeat" message to boost something called "self" esteem" now dominates Christian pulpits in the West. So repentance is deemed unnecessary, unbecoming, even "negative". So it is neglected. The Feast of Trumpets is an alarm. It is a call to a season of repentance. This fact is swept under the carpet. Yom Teruah will initiate the final seven years leading up to our final exam on Judgment Day, the Day of Atonement. So if Yom Teruah is indeed a call to assembly before God, a call to repentance, to prayer, to fasting, as we see in Joel 2 would not the **Teruah** shofar blast be appropriate for such a time as this?



15. Blow the trumpet in Zion, declare a holy fast, call a sacred assembly. 16. Gather the people, consecrate the assembly; bring together the elders,gather the children, those nursing at the breast. Let the bridegroom leave his room and the bride her chamber. 17. Let the priests, who minister before the LORD, weep between the portico and the altar.

Is all of God's work really done? Has the fullness of the Gentiles been brought in? And has not the Shepherd of Israel said that He will call His sheep by name and gather them to Himself in the latter days. And might they do better repenting, that is, turning around, and coming to Him instead of going their own way?




As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

Now let us take a look at the **terminus** of those **final 7** years. Yom Kippur or the Day of Atonement is a rehearsal for **Judgment Day**. And what else might we expect to happen on that day? In Leviticus 25 God through Moses ordained that the *trumpets of Jubilee* were to sound every 49 years on Tishri 10 right on the Day of Atonement. So might we not expect that the trumpets sounding on that final wrap-up **Day of Accounting** will also be announcing that long awaited climactic Jubilee of Messiah? Such an awesome future Day of Atonement would not only mark the terminus of this present evil age. It would also usher us into the next age, the glorious Millennium of Messiah.

There is now an upwelling of interest in the Feasts of the Lord. These are the moeds, the appointed times of Yehovah the Almighty Eternal God. This makes for some very interesting discussions. Right now God's called-out covenant people are divided. They are in two estranged and sometimes feuding camps.

### ISRAEL and the CHURCH





But we need to remember this. Back at the last feast, the *Feast of Pentecost*, did we not see two *LEAVENED* loaves lifted up? Leaven is a type of sin. So Pentecost, great blessing that this has been, will not take us to the end of our journey. By itself it will not deliver. So then, if God has some further dealings with all His covenant people might we not expect that He will accomplish this during the Fall Feasts.



15 'You shall also count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day when you brought in the sheaf of the wave offering; there shall be seven complete Sabbaths. 16 You shall count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall present a new grain offering to the Lord.

17 You shall bring in from your dwelling places two *loaves* of bread for a wave offering, made of two-tenths *of an ephah*; they shall be of a fine flour, *baked with leaven* as first fruits to the LORD. - Lev. 23:15-17


Two witnesses stand before the God of the earth. There is a genuine witness to God's Law, to His righteous rule, and to His Kingdom that will come to earth under Messiah. There is also a witness to God's Grace and His mercy in the Gospel. Both have their angelic witness standing before the God of the earth. They are showcased at the mercy seat, the very throne of God.



The prophet Zechariah saw two olive trees emptying their oil into a golden bowl supplying the oil for the seven branched candlestick, the menorah, the true and genuine symbol of Israel. In Zechariah 4 we see that the two olive trees are described as "the two anointed ones who stand before the God of the earth."



In Revelation chapter 11 John is told that "the two witnesses are the two olive trees and the two lampstands, and they stand before the Lord of the earth." Each sheds light on the pieces of the puzzle to reveal the mystery of Israel. In Messiah the two great lights complement each other beautifully. And so as the story plays out the Sabbath prayers will be answered and the promised restoration of all Israel will surely come. This magnificent piece of apocalyptic art is by the Jewish artist Eizen. His work can be purchased at the Israeli Poster Center.



In Christ, in our Messiah, all the pieces do come together. And they will come together. All these mysteries will be revealed. But the final wrap-up awaits the re-gathering, the repentance, and the refining of all Israel. This is what God will be doing in the latter days. Even now, as holy history unfolds positive things are beginning to happen. Each faction is finding themselves strangely blessed by the other. We are in fact seeing the early stirrings of the epic latter day re-union and restoration of all Israel. How wonderful is that?

Israel includes both the nation, (or the scepter of Israel in the royal throne of David in the Jewish house of Judah) and the Congregation of Israel or as we call it "the Church". In Ezekiel 37 the prophet saw the two separated entities as two sticks that were to be re-united. The two estranged houses of Israel are to be restored to each other at the climax of the age and will become one. The Apostle Paul spoke of those who are saved under the atoning blood of Christ, (Israel's promised Sacrifice Lamb), as entering into the Commonwealth of Israel. This reunion will surely happen. But both parties are in partial blindness to these things at this point in time.







Scales are now coming off the eyes. Christians are now starting to see that **Yom Teruah**, AKA the **Feast of** *Trumpets,* is not just a Jewish holiday. And our Jewish friends are now beginning to see that the divine appointment they rehearse every year is more than just a time for dipping apples in honey and saying "Have a sweet New Year". As we saw in our other videos, the Teruah is an urgent awakening. It is the Voice of God, a summons to all His covenant people to fasting, prayer, and to repentance. It is also the day of the "joyful sound". So this future Day of the Teruah must be a very important day up there in our future.



As we shared in a previous video on **Yom Teruah**, there are four classic Hebrew shofar blasts. This traditional sequence goes back into antiquity. The **Teruah shofar blast** is **not** the **last** trumpet in the sequence. It is the third. And as we have seen, the Teruah gives Yom Teruah its name. It is the trumpet of alarm, an awakening, a revival, a call to repentance, and a summons to assembly before God. It is a remembrance of God. And in the shout and in the trumpet blast we cry out to Him to remember us.

The Teruah shofar blast has a certain musical character. In the sharply chopped sound there is an alarm and an urgent appeal. God's people are in a state of distress and brokenness. And in that same *Teruah trumpet blast* and in the **shout** God is echoing back to His people with an inspiring summons to assembly before Him and before Him alone. In the *Teruah* God's people experience a great blessing. The divine Presence descends down upon them.



So what is God's purpose in that future epic Yom **Teruah**? What will happen when His covenant people hear the call on that awesome future eye popping day when the 7 year covenant of Daniel 9:27 is confirmed? We can be sure that there will be an awakening. A great wave of repentance and a great anointing will sweep over the covenant people of God. Will it trigger the great End Time Revival, the one Joel and Isaiah and Hosea and all the other prophets spoke about? Is it possible that we shall yet see the true and genuine Latter Rain outpouring?



If this is so then what would be God's purpose in this? Might we expect God's Holy Spirit Outpouring to guide and to empower His saints as they make their stand for Him in the latter days? And will this End-Time Revival among God's covenant people be happening at the very same time as the Great End-Time Falling Away? . . Quite possibly so.



In Leviticus 23 the God of Israel through Moses lays out **Yom Teruah** as a "Day of Blowing" as of trumpets. It is also stated to be a memorial day. Why is Yom Teruah to be a memorial? This will certainly be a day in which God's people remember their God and call out to Him to remember them. But is there more to the story?

#### **Leviticus 23**

24. Speak 1696 unto the children 1121 of Israel 3478, saying 559, In the seventh 7637 month 2320, in the first 259 [day] of the month 2320, shall ye have a sabbath 7677, a memorial 2146 of blowing 8643 of trumpets, an holy 6944 convocation 4744. 25. Ye shall do 6213 no servile 5656 work 4399 [therein]: but ye shall offer 7126 an offering made by fire 801 unto the LORD 3068.

This memorial issue is a big lead worthy of our study. On that epic future **Yom Teruah** the people of the eternal covenant will stop in their tracks. They will *remember* their God in a very public way. At the sounding of the *Teruah* His covenant people will be calling upon their God to re-member them, His dismembered people in their hour of need. This two way calling to re-membrance between God and His called out people is a consequence of the Everlasting Covenant, the Abrahamic covenant that blossoms forth in the New Covenant.



There is yet another more somber reason why Yom Teruah may become a *memorial* day with the blowing of trumpets. A good investigator taps into leads such as this one. Because we are looking at a memorial that according to *Psalm 81* occurs on a new moon and on a solemn feast day. But we shall have to pursue this clue in another video.



The word *Teruah* does not mean trumpet. This is our big neglected clue. The Teruah is the divine "wake-up call" of God. It is His Voice, His inspiration coming to us IN the blowing of the trumpet, IN the shout, IN the joyful sound etc.. So it seems that on some awesome future Jewish New Year **Someone** will be speaking **to** His people and through His people and rather loudly. God will be calling out in and to His people in and through all these many and varied expressions of the Teruah.

Blowing, (as of trumpets) Shouting, ALARM!, Joyful sound, (assoc. with) Tumult.

The *Teruah* is a wellspring in which flows the *divine* Presence of God. He speaks to us IN the trumpet blast, IN the shout, IN the call to attention, and IN the call to repentance and IN the proclaiming of a soon coming King. He *IS* the *awakening* in the trumpet blast, He IS the joy in the joyful sound, He IS the exaltation in the clashing of cymbals, the One who overflows by His Holy Spirit. He is the Holy One of Israel who in His Person wells up in His people through all of these manifold expressions of the Teruah.



Yom Teruah is most often referred to as **Rosh Hashanah**, the Jewish New Year. Christians use the term Feast of **Trumpets.** But the Biblical name for the feast, has been neglected. The phrase **Yom Teruah** just gets a mere **1%** of the Google inquiries. And yet the word *Teruah* is all through the Scriptures. It occurs 33 times in the King James Bible. Sadly, there is almost no Bible teaching on the word Teruah. So the true meaning of the feast remains hidden. So lets look at these passages to see how the word *Teruah* is used throughout the Bible. This will give us further insight into what will actually be happening on that momentous future Yom Teruah.

#### The Hebrew word TERUAH signifies REVIVAL & EXALTATION!

Lev. 23:24 "the *blowing* of trumpets."

Num. 10:5 & 5 "blow an alarm."

Num. 23:21 "the shout of a king."

Num. 29:1 "the blowing of trumpets."

Jos. 6:5 "a great *shout* and the wall will come down".

2Chr. 13:12 "priests with sounding trumpets to cry alarm."

Ezr. 3:12 "the foundation laid, .. many *shouted* aloud for joy."

Psa. 27:6 "I will offer, ..sacrifices of joy, ... I will sing praises."

Psa. 33:3 "sing .. a new song, .. skilfully with a loud noise."

Psa. 89:15 "Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound."

Psa. 150:5 "praise Him upon the high *sounding* cymbals."


Jer. 4:19 "the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war."

Biblical Christians enjoy a two way communication with God. The Teruah will see an outpouring of *God's anointing* and an upwelling response echoing back to Him from His people. Yom **Teruah** is the next **blow-out event in future holy history**. God's covenant people will be in a crisis. They'll be facing a political and a religious bust. The national sovereignty of their country and their personal freedom will be in jeopardy. Many will be angry at God for not rapturing them. Many will fall away in apostasy. But as the shofars sound the Elect will look up and **remember** their God. Their eyes will be upon Him and Him alone. On that day as they remember the eternal covenant a wave of repentance will break forth. Prayers and supplications will go up to heaven. The true and genuine *latter rain* will fall and the **Holy Spirit** will begin to flow in a glorious flooding wave.

Sanctify a fast. Consecrate the people. Let the priests/pastors weep between the porch and the altar.



Yom Teruah carries with it another important clue. Our Jewish friends know full well that this feast does not herald an epic conclusion or a closure. Rather, it is an *opener* into the *days* of awe. And on top of That we have another big neglected clue here. The Teruah shofar blast is only the third of the four classic shofar sounds.


The *Feast of Trumpets* is an opener into the *days* of awe. This is a period of repentance preparing God's people to face the soon coming Day of Atonement. 



If we are honest with ourselves we have to conclude that the *Teruah* does not sound like the *last trump*. It is not the proper herald for the occasion. The highly broken staccato trumpet sound of the Teruah penetrates the soul like nothing else. It is an alarm, an urgent call to wake up, to assemble before God for a briefing. It is a call to repent, to change our mind, to prepare for a challenge that is now upon us. Biblically and historically the *Teruah* was blown in response to a clear and present danger or a major security threat. God has always used the Teruah to call His people to Himself to prepare them to face a very significant turn of events and to deliver them from an approaching enemy.







Can we read Time magazine or the Economist and then step on over and open our Bible and connect the dots?







We sing about our God being an awesome God. But in our hearts and minds and in the devotion that directs our will, just how awesome are we willing for Him to be?





The Final 7 Years of This Age

Some are saying that the future 70th Week and the time of *Jacob's trouble* is just for Israel. Similarly they say that the **Seventy Weeks prophecy** was a message for "Daniel's people", i.e. the Jews. But Biblical prophecy is not limited to the royal Jewish house of Judah or just the land of Israel as we have being told. Daniel's people are a much bigger company. The promise given to Abraham was that His Seed (singular), (who is Christ), would become a "melo-hagoyim", a huge multitude of Gentiles or nations more numerous than the stars of heaven.

"And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.."



So even if our country is dissolved in a New World Order or we are exiled, or worse, we do have hope. Because in Christ we do belong to another country. So we can be issued with a new and very wonderful passport. And our pilgrimage towards that ultimate "city upon a hill" goes on.



## 7 Years of DEEP REPENTANCE

God states that the 70 Weeks of Daniel are the times He Himself has determined, made holy, set apart, or cut out of time, for dealings related to both His Holy City and His Holy People. This will be especially so during those final 7 years.

Daniel 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city

Repentance is very necessary. God chastens us. He wants to develop His character in us. We will wrestle with God over the same issues our father Jacob did. The issues of the latter days are monumental. But these trials and tribulations are **not** the wrath of God upon us. They bring the very necessary refining to change us from shifty dodgy Jacob to Israel, one who has contended and become a prince with God. Back in the former time Jacob underwent this character change through wrestling with God. He struggled with Him all through a dark night of the soul. For us, it will be no different. Because we, the Judeo-Christian people, (and not just our Jewish brethren), are that tricky shyster Jacob. That state of affairs has to change. And by the prophesied trials, tribulations, and refining it will change.



So why is God doing all this? If we look at the burdens of the 70 Weeks of prophecy we find out. The final seven years will come to their appointed climax. And just what will God have achieved in and through His covenant people by their witness and by His climactic return? Here are the bullet points that will wrap up God's agenda. When these jobs are done our Messiah will have returned and be all set to establish His Millennial Kingdom.

- 1. to finish the transgression,
- 2. to make an end of sins,
- 3. to make reconciliation for iniquity,
- 4. to bring in everlasting righteousness,
- 5. to seal up the vision and prophecy,
- 6. and to anoint the most Holy.
- Dan. 9:25

So the days of awe, this season of soul searching and repentance is very necessary. And it begins on Yom Teruah, the Feast of Trumpets. It runs on up through the days of awe to terminate on the ultimate Day of Atonement, Yom Kippur, at the end of this age.



Now let's look at another big clue to understanding the Feast of Trumpets. Going back to the former times Yom Teruah has been referred to by the idiom, "the opening of the gates".



The God of the Bible talks a lot about entering into His gates. And there are lots of sacred songs about this. Who are these people who will enter in through the gates? Here in this verse the God of Israel through the prophet Isaiah in Isaiah 26:2 says that

"the righteous nation that preserves and upholds the truth will enter in."




Open ye the gates that the righteous nation which keepeth the truth may enter in.

- Isa. 26:2

In the book of Lamentations the prophet Jeremiah laments the destruction of Jerusalem He especially laments God's covenant people being cut-off from the feasts.


"The ways of Zion do mourn, because none come to the solemn feasts: all her gates are desolate: her priests sigh, her virgins are afflicted, and she is in bitterness." - Lam. 1:4



2600 years later this same lament is still just as applicable to us today. And here we are. Nothing much has changed since Jeremiah made that statement. And even today with the best churches and speakers that money can buy how many of God's people gathered in big mega-churches like this are being properly prepared for the latter days? How many even open up their Bibles or access the free online Lexicons to learn about the momentous future fulfillment of **Yom Teruah**?



So our God, the God of Israel is about to change all that. He is about to open up the gates. He wants to invite His covenant people to walk on in fellowship with Him. But it is a strait and narrow gate. And our entry will require some adjustments on our part. So who is going to help us here?




It seems the Holy One of Israel has made some special arrangements for us. With the Teruah there is good news. This sad state of affairs is about to change. On a blockbuster future *Feast* of Trumpets, Yom Teruah the watchmen will sound the call. God will give His people strength for the journey and grace for the trials. He will provide help from above, unfailing sympathy, undying love. All this will happen, as they assemble before *Him*, . . and *Him alone*.

## Joel 2:1

Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day f the LORD is coming. It is close at hand-

On that spellbinding future **Yom** Teruah He will be opening wide the gates! He will be calling all men to His great salvation, preparing them, and when they can't go on, He will be carrying them across a threshold towards their glorious eternal destiny with Him.



The Opening of the Gates

Many scripture passages tell of people from many heathen Gentile nations coming up to Jerusalem. They are received in the outer court, the court of the Gentiles. How is it then that people who enter in as heathen Gentiles go on to enter through that inner gate to be admitted into the sanctuary? How are they adopted into that one single righteous nation Israel, a nation that keeps the truth?

Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, - Isaiah 60:11



Apparently something is happening in the outer court of the Gentiles. There is some sifting and some refining going on. The prophet Ezekiel tells of a people passing through an inner gate into the inner court. This inner court is variously described as the Court of Priests or the Court of Israel.



This scripture passage from Ezekiel 44:17 describes the future Millennial Temple. It speaks of linen garments and sheds some further light on this subject.

"And it shall come to pass, that when they enter in at the gates of the inner court, they shall be clothed with linen garments; and no wool shall come upon them whilst they minister in the gates of the inner court, and within". (i.e. the sanctuary).

- Ezekiel 44:17

And why are these people inside the court of Israel all wearing fine raiment or white linen garments? What is the meaning of fine white linen raiment in Biblical symbology? This is clearly interpreted for us in Revelation 19:8. The fine linen is the righteousness of the saints.

And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the *righteousness of the saints*.

- Revelation 19:8


And in the previous verse, Revelation 19:7 we see another clue that helps us understand the meaning of the "fine linen, clean and white." It seems to be a picture of the white raiment worn by a bride as she prepares to go to her wedding. The imagery here is showing the ultimate holy or set-apart state of God's covenant people as they go out through a dark night to meet the Bridegroom.

"Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready."

- Revelation 19:7



We get another view of this matter of preparation with the story Jesus told us of a wedding party preparing to go out to meet the Bridegroom. It is the parable of the ten virgins. Some were prepared. And some were not.



In Revelation 21 we see the Bride of the Lamb positively identified for us as the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, and within the City all her People.



So **Yom Teruah** is an entrée into a time of refinement. We see a major clue to **Yom Teruah** in Joel chapter 2. The God of Israel is calling all His people to assembly. So those final seven years are a period of re-gathering. The God of Israel will be calling **all** His people to sanctify themselves before Him because He will soon be returning as King of kings. The true priests and ministers will be like the rest of us. They will be repenting, weeping between the porch and the altar.

Joel 2: <sup>15</sup> Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: 16 Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet. <sup>17</sup> Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar,


A time of refining is not as "negative" as we might think. God's true covenant people will not fall away in anger. This may be a season of good grief but not bad grief. There will be refining, like the refining of fine linen, as a heckle refining flax. This is the way impurities are removed to make fine linen for white raiment.



Our verse in Joel 2 speaks of the Trumpet being blown on "a day of clouds and thick darkness". Have we heard any mention of a day of clouds and thick darkness before?


"Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the Day of the LORD cometh, for it is nigh at hand; A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, ..." - Joel 2:1-2a

Indeed we have. In Ezekiel 34:12 we read, "As a shepherd seeks out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the *cloudy* and dark day." This is our God of mercy at work. This is what He will be doing even in the midst of the Great Tribulation as the dreadful Day of the Lord draws near.



As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

So why is the Holy One of Israel opening the gates and bidding His people to go through the gates at the time of **Yom Teruah**? Why is He clearing the highway and lifting up a standard for the people? It seems that He wants to gather in as many people as He can into His sanctification and refinement. Because the end of the age draws near and with it the Judgment, the Day of Reckoning, or Day of Atonement. Then time will have run out. The Day of the Lord will open up and He will loose and send forth the angels of the harvest.



Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people. - Isa. 62:10


## The song "Go through the gates"

So will the Resurrection-Rapture come on the Feast of Trumpets as most of our dispensational churchmen are saying? At this point in our study we see no evidence for that. It seems that on a day that will shake all nations the Teruah shofar blasts God will be calling all men to be holy or "set apart" to Him. Like a loving father with His children, our God wants to gather and spend some "quality time" with His covenant people.

## "The LORD is in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him,"

Habakkuk 2:20

If God wants to save as many people as He can why are we, His people destined for this rough passage? Perhaps He wants all hands on deck, even as a captain needs his crew to stay with him during a tempest. Acts 27 describes the shipwreck of the Apostle Paul. The ship was being driven onto a lee to shore in a tempest. Four anchors from the stern held the ship. At midnight Paul saw a strange sight. The crew were furtively lowering the lifeboat. They were deserting. They were skipping out to save their lives before the voyage came to its final frightening climax. The Apostle Paul took a dim view of this and alerted the captain who put a stop to the cowardly act. The crew had been commissioned to serve to the end of the journey.



How about us as born-again Biblical Christians? When does our journey end? When does our commission expire? Is it at the end of the age? Or is it seven years before that? Should we take this document, the Great Commission, to our lawyer and ask him to tell us? Or can we read what is written ourselves?

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations,



"The opening of the gates" is a time of soul searching, tears, and repentance. But there is joy as well. In the Psalms we read the songs of ascent. We sing about entering His gates with thanksgiving in our hearts and entering His courts with praise. Just as Hosea did with wayward Gomer, God is wooing us back to Himself. He is drawing us, calling us to go up on that highway of holiness and to meet with Him in His sanctuary. In the Hebrew dancing we hear songs of joyful invitation to "Go through the gates", and "prepare the way of the people". The God of Israel is throwing open the gates to His Holy Place. He wants us go up to Zion in joyful praise. This is another wonderful item of Hebrew art by Yossi Rosenstein. His works can be found online at art.com.



By now we are starting to get an idea of where this all ends. The days of awe come to a climax and end on Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement. In Hebrew tradition this is the last chance to repent for that year. As the sun sets on this *Day* of Reckoning this awesome moment of closure is referred to by the well known Hebrew idiom, "the closing of the gates". Yom Kippur The Day of Atonement

This is also referred to and alluded to in Scripture as the Day of Reckoning, Day of Sentencing, Day of Pardoning, Day of Accounting, Day of Reconciliation, or in other words, *Judgment Day!* 




Our search for the true meaning and the ultimate fulfillment of the *Day of Atonement* must of necessity take us to the synagogue and the celebration and the annual rehearsal of **Yom Kippur** by our Jewish friends. The final service on **Yom Kippur at sunset** is called the **Neilah**. The rabbis say that as the awesome day of Yom Kippur comes to a close their future is being sealed. They turn to God to accept their sincere repentance and new resolutions. They ask that He seal them in the **Book of Life**, granting them a new year replete with goodness and happiness.



The Ark housing the Torah scrolls remains open right up until the end of the *Neilah service*, signifying that the Gates of Heaven are still wide open for prayers and entreaties.



After a final declaration of faith, the shofar sounds climactically with the Tekia Gedolah. Then after some closing prayers the service ends with an awesome moment of closure. Neilah means "closing the gate." As the Neilah service ends the doors to the ark are closed. At that point the clock has run out. There is no more time to have your name inscribed in the Book of Life. As the sun sets on this awesome *Day of Judgment* those present in the synagogue feel the weight of this awesome moment of finality. Yom Kippur is a rehearsal for that ultimate future **Judgment Day** when on the last day of this age we stand face to face with God. This an aspect of our Hebrew roots well worth knowing about and actually experiencing.



So here we have some more pieces of the puzzle indicating very strongly that the *Fall Feasts* do in fact initiate and terminate a very significant future time period marked by *repentance*. It begins with *Yom* Teruah which is linked to the "opening of the gates" and ends with the **Day of Atonement**, or **Yom Kippur** which features the "closing of the gates". This is further strong evidence that these two yet to be fulfilled Fall Feasts do provide the appropriate settings for these epic future events as well as mark out a precise timeline for the final 7 years of this age.



Now let's look at the **Day of Atonement** as a *LEGAL MATTER*. This final judgment will be handed down by Christ our Messiah and nobody else. So then, is this not the Judgment Seat of Christ? As we saw, Yom Kippur is a rehearsal for that final Judgment Day. And in some future year the tenth day of Tishri will in fact erupt into holy history and world history as the long awaited Day of Reckoning.



The *Day of Atonement* will be the last day of this present evil age. Most would agree that the very idea of Judgment Day conveys a definite sense of finality and closure. And when the sun sets on the Day of Accounting the Day of the Lord will then open up to **EXECUTE** the Judgment. With this will come our transport and our assignment to a new destiny, hopefully a good one.



The Final 7 Years of This Age

Yes, Judgment Day is the end of the road for this age, the end of the term, and the *final exam* in which we pass or fail. After this school "breaks up". It is very important for us to understand that there are two parts to a judgment. The first part is the legal judgment or the verdict handed down by the court.



We all stand guilty before God.
Without a *an atonement,* without someone standing in the gap for us on *That Day* we will be of all men most miserable.

## "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Romans 3:23

Without a personal covering for sin on that ultimate Day of Reckoning our guilty state before a holy God will condemn us to eternal damnation.



# The Scriptures are very plain here. "How shall we escape, if we neglect so great a salvation." - Heb. 2:3





On that future *Day of Accounting* those who know Messiah as Savior and Lord will be justified. This justification is not based upon any good works we have done. So how then can we be saved?



The Elect, the Chosen people from both sides of Calvary, are all saved the same way. They are saved by God's grace through their faith in the shed blood of Israel's promised Sacrifice Lamb. This is the blood we saw featured back in the Spring Feast of Passover. The blood of Israel's Sacrifice Lamb is ultimate and final blood of atonement. That blood was shed 2000 years ago by our Messiah in His first coming in His priestly role as the Suffering Servant.



Judgment Day will surely come, for all of us. For some the verdict will be "guilty as charged" and for others the verdict will be "not guilty". Then we come to Step 2 which is the **EXECUTION** of that judgment. Those who have been justified by faith in our Lord Jesus will be released to Eternal Life. Those who have rejected Him will be condemned to death and eternal separation from God.

We see these same two stages of a Judgment in our courts here below. How will the judgment be executed? In blood covenant matters the person standing trial will either be pardoned or condemned. The execution of the judgment will be either the release of the person or *death*.

Here on the left is a legal judgment concluding with a verdict and a sentencing handed down by the court. This was one of the Nurenberg trials for a Nazi war criminal. In the legal judgment over on the left this person was found guilty of war crimes and sentenced to death. Over on the right we see the execution of that prior judgment. The condemned man was taken out to the gallows and hanged.

So. We have a legal judgment and we have a an execution of that judgment. Which one comes first? And which one comes after it? We all should know the answer to that question. In point of fact we all do know it. We know it very well.




Here we have a happier *legal judgment* and after that we have a much happier execution of that judgment. In this case a man charged with a crime was found "not guilty". Evidence involving blood and DNA had proven him innocent and he was pardoned. So here the execution of a judgment was the *release* of the prisoner. This was a touching story. The previously condemned man and the advocate who had worked tirelessly to secure his justification and release fell in love with each other and married. Wouldn't it be wonderful if Christians fell in love with the Advocate who has loved them and saved them.

So does an *execution* of a judgment precede the judgment? Does a man's hanging or his being set free come before his day in court or after his day in court? Well we know the answer to that question very well. An execution should always follow a proper legal judgment, right? This is the normal procedure of righteous law. We have seen this sequence played out many times.

OK, now, let's look at our own day in court, our own Judgment Day. Our Judgment and that of everyone else will come down on the Day of Atonement, on the last day of this age. Let's consider the sequence we should expect for Judgment Day and the execution of that judgment.



The execution of all the verdicts handed down at Judgment Day will follow quickly. At sunset of that last day of this age the Day of the Lord will open up. The heavens will unfold as a scroll, space-time will unzip and a vortex will open up between heaven and earth. This will be the opening of the Day of the Lord. Out of this portal his will come angels of the Harvest Jesus spoke about in Matthew 13.



We are ALL going before the throne of God on that last day to face the Judgment. An idiom for the *Day of Atonement* is this matter of being "face to face" with God. No one passes into their eternal destiny without passing by Messiah at the Judgment Seat of Christ.



The Bible lays this out very clearly. In 1Corinthians 5:10 we read; "For we must ALL appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that everyone may be recompensed for the things done in His body, according to what he has done, whether it be good or bad."

"For we must **ALL** appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that everyone may be recompensed for the things done in His body, according to what he has done, whether it be good or bad."

And no unsaved adult living mortal person alive on this earth at the end of this age will enter the Millennium of Messiah without going through the Sheep-Goat Judgment.



So the Judgment will come at the end of this age. After the judgment comes the execution of that judgment. This is precisely the same sequence of events we see in courts all around the world. It is the pattern we have seen since ancient times. After Messiah renders His judgment the harvest angels will be loosed to execute the judgment.




How will Messiah judge us? Will it be on the basis of the preponderance of our good works? No, every person falls short there. As the Scriptures declare, "All our works of righteousness are as filthy rags." So then. By what means then can we hope to be justified before a holy God?



#### The Bible declares that it is "Not by works of righteousness that we have done but according to His mercy He saves us."



So then, just how are we to avail ourselves of God's mercy? How are we to be saved from the wrath to come? In Ephesians 2:8-9 our Apostle Paul declares, "For it is by grace that you have been saved, through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works, lest any man should boast."



So God has extended His grace to us. But how can a just God let us off the hook? The wages of sin is death and all of us are guilty sinners. Who is going to be covering for us here?

It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the Living God. Remember what happened back at Sinai? Moses had to put up boundary markers to protect the children of Israel lest God's wrath flash out. They could not even approach the mountain of God.

So how can we come face to face with the Judge of the Universe given our sinful fallen state? How are we to be justified before a righteous holy God? Who is covering for us here? And just how is our Savior covering for us on Judgment Day?



The **Day of Atonement** is a Day of Covering for sin. This is a *kippah*, in Jewish tradition and symbology it is a covering for the head. This is a wonderful reminder for us of our sinful condition before a holy God and our need for a covering before Him. But on that awesome Day of Reckoning, Day of Reconciliation of Accounts, Day of Atonement, we are going to need more than a kippah. How then can we hope to be saved from the wrath of God?



We find our answer here. The Ark of the Covenant was showcased in the former times under Moses and under the Levitical priesthood. The High Priest went into the Holy of Holies to minister here once a year. That day happened to be the **Day of Atonement**, Yom Kippur, the Day of Covering. The two angels are looking down at the mercy seat that sits atop the Ark. These are the two witnesses that stand before the Lord of the earth. They are witness to a climactic blood atonement that will ultimately unfold on the **last day** of this age up in the heavenly sanctuary.




And this is where that blood of atonement came from. Our Savior was Israel's promised Sacrifice Lamb, slain from the foundation of the world. This blood, shed at Calvary on Passover by the sinless spotless Lamb of God purchased our salvation. This blood is the only blood that can cleanse us from sin. This blood is the only blood covering acceptable for that ultimate atonement. Was the blood shed back at Calvary applied to the mercy seat right then and there? Was the blood of atonement applied to the mercy seat when we were saved? No it was not. This ultimate final service performed by our High Priest awaits the final ingathering, and the ultimate Day of Atonement.



We can trace the blood of the Lamb of God in the Seventy Weeks prophecy from the terminus of the 69 weeks and Calvary and then onward across a gap of 2,000 odd years. The future 70th Week will end and on the Day of Atonement the blood of atonement will be applied to the mercy seat.

And similarly in the layout of the Tabernacle we can see at the altar the Lamb of God slain from the foundation of the world. And on the Yom Kippur service showcased there we see the blood of the Sacrifice Lamb as it is carried on into the Sanctuary, through the veil, and into the Holy of holies to the Ark and the mercy seat.



Lamb will be sprinkled on the mercy seat atop the Ark of the Covenant.

Calvary and on into the Holy of Holies.

Every year the High Priest entered beyond the veil into the most Holy Place. We need to be respectful of God's order of things. There is only **one day** in the year in which the **blood of atonement** could pass through curtain and into the *Holy of Holies*. That Day is *Yom* Kippur. God is telling us something here. Yeshua's High Priestly ministry at the Holy of Holies cannot happen on just any old day. The final atonement must occur on the *Day of Atonement*! This is the set time, the appointed time when the Presence of God is manifest over the Mercy Seat in the Holy of Holies.




The general theme and an idiom for the *Day* of Atonement is this matter of coming face to face with God. At the end of the age we must all present ourselves before the Ancient of Days. But we cannot even hope to approach Him without a covering, an atonement for sin. The name, Yom Kippur, Day of Covering, points to the necessity of a person being covered on that awesome day



If we are to come before God face to face without His covering then our sins, our debts, our transgressions will be our doom. Unless an intermediary, Somebody who is without sin, provides a blood covering for our sin, God's wrath will surely fall on us and we shall be totally and absolutely damned!








But for those who have by faith surrendered themselves to Jesus / Yeshua the judgment will be a happier one. Because Jesus is our High Priest after the Order of Melchizedek. And on an epic future **Yom Kippur** He will provide that blood covering for all of us. On that Day our Messiah will sprinkle His own blood, the ultimate blood covering on the mercy seat in the Heavenly Sanctuary.



And on *That Day*, all the previous blood sacrifices offered up by faith to God in all the times past before and under the Levitical Priesthood will be covered. Under the Old Covenant the children of the faith of Abraham were saved just as people are saved today. They were justified by faith, faith in God and in what He had spoken. And for those who believed it was counted for them as righteousness. People were never saved by the blood of these animal sacrifices per se. These were a show-and-tell of an ultimate sacrifice yet to come. It was not by the keeping of the law but by God's grace through faith that they were saved. The ultimate blood covering and the final atonement for sin, was to be provided in a time yet future.




God was not looking for the blood of bulls and goats and sheep. And with His friend Abraham God was not looking for the blood of Isaac to be shed. He was looking for a sacrificial willingness of heart and a declaration of faith in his partner Abraham. God asked him to surrender up the very thing most dear to his heart, his only son. When God saw that Abraham was willing to do this it was enough. He sent the angel to stop the sacrifice. In the two way but unconditional Abrahamic Covenant, God would then send *His son* to be our Sacrifice Lamb.



Abraham was then given a wonderful promise, that great salvation verse from the Old Testament. He was told, "God will provide HIMSELF, a Lamb." He looked around and saw the lamb caught in the briars. The thorns were wrapped around His head. This was a foreshadowing of the ultimate future Sacrifice Lamb.

<sup>7</sup> And Isaac spoke to Abraham his father, and said, "My father:" and he said, "Here am I, my son." And he said, "Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?" <sup>8</sup> And Abraham said, "My son, God will provide HIMSELF a lamb . . . " 13 And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.



The spotless Lamb of God would be provided from heaven. The thorns were wrapped around His head. Our Lord Jesus would shoulder the cost of our redemption. His blood would purchase salvation for many and for the sinners that we all are. This blood of the Lamb covers and justifies us before a holy God. Only by this blood can we face the Judge and to have Him hand down a verdict of "not guilty".



The cutting of a covenant brings the blood of atonement. This brings peace between God and man. Men of faith know that through the blood God will provide for them. The patriarchs of old all understood by. It is a central theme throughout Holy Scripture. Our spiritual father Abraham showcased this blood covenant with Yehovah-God 4,000 years ago. It was an unconditional blood covenant cut between God and Abraham's family of faith. This faith in the atoning blood of Israel's Promised Sacrifice Lamb is the essence of the New Covenant.




Faith in the God who provides the ultimate blood of atonement is the foundation for the Everlasting Covenant. The blood of the animals was never the object. The sacrifices served only to showcase the gravity of our transgressions. Before we can walk with God we need to see the terrible consequences of our sin. We need to ponder the cost of our reconciliation before a holy God.

The ultimate and final and acceptable blood of atonement was shed at Calvary. This blood covers our sin and restores the fellowship between God and His people. Out of this realization comes a broken and contrite heart. This in turn brings us into a deep fellowship with the one who made the sacrifice for us.


## Psalm 51

17. For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it. thou delightest not in burnt offering. 18. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.

So out of the promises of Abraham and from the faith that calls out to God from a broken and penitent heart comes our great salvation. The promised **Seed of Abraham**, the Lamb of God, came to us as Immanuel, God with us, God incarnate, God in the flesh. Israel's **Suffering Servant** came to this earth to fulfill the role as our **Redeemer**. He walked among us. Then He offered Himself up, shedding His blood to provide the ultimate and final atonement for sin. He explained all this to His disciples at the *Last Supper*. Even now He is calling all who will hear His voice to come into His great salvation and follow Him.



And on a future epic *Day of Atonement* this same Jesus/Yeshua our High Priest of the high Order of Melchizedek will minister in the new covenant on our behalf up in the heavenly sanctuary. On That Day He will sprinkle His own blood, the ultimate blood of Atonement upon the mercy seat. This is described in the Book of Hebrews, chapter 7, 8 & 9.



The timing of this future atonement and covering for sin is laid out for us in Hebrews 9. This Scripture couldn't be clearer. The atonement will occur at the end of the age. This ultimate atonement will be witnessed, and accepted at the Ark of the covenant in the heavenly sanctuary. On That Day, and not before, our justification will be fully ratified before God for His courts above.

23 It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with *better sacrifices* than these. 24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: 25 Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others; 26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: BUT NOW, ONCE, in the END OF THE WORLD / AGE hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself." - Hebrews 9:23-26


The two angels will be there to witness this ultimate Yom Kippur. One of these angels is a witness to God's Grace and Mercy such as we see in the Gospel. The other angel is a witness to the fulfillment of *His righteousness in the* Law. Jesus/Yeshua, our High Priest and coming King, will satisfy both. His blood will cover the sins of all the Elect coming from both sides of Calvary. And on *That Day* all who have lived and died in the faith will be justified.



The Ark of the Covenant was revered as the very Throne of Yehovah, the Eternal Almighty God. God was envisioned by Israel as sitting enthroned upon the Mercy Seat.



As our Scripture passage from Hebrews 9:27 goes on to say, "It is appointed unto men once to die, and after this, the Judgment." So whether we pass from this life by death or by living here on earth right up to the last day of the age we shall still arrive here, at the Judgment.



"It is appointed unto men once to die, and after this, the Judgment." Heb. 9:27


The Day of Judgment is the final Day of Atonement. It is the ultimate Yom Kippur, the conclusive Day of Covering. All who have known and trusted Christ our coming Messiah will be blessed. They will see Him "face to face" and they will live and not die. The Elect will pass from the valley of the shadow of death and on into Life eternal.



So as we can see, the **Day of Atonement** is a very somber moment of closure for all who live upon this earth. When the sun sets on that final **Yom** Kippur of all Yom Kippurs it will truly be the last chance to repent. As we have seen, an idiom for the **Day of Atonement** and the meaning of the word *Neilah* is "closing of the gates". For those who would seek reconciliation with God the time has run out. Would that not be a suitable and auspicious time for the *Last Trumpet* to sound?

Revelation 10:7 and 11:15 are the two references to the 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet. This is a single trumpet blast As we see, it will be sounded by an angel and not by men. The two verses here tell the story. And the time reference here could not be clearer. The 7<sup>th</sup> trumpet marks the time when

- 1. the mystery of God is finished and
- 2. the kingdoms of this world become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Messiah.

So if the 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet sounds at the consummation of the age then it is indeed the *last trumpet*.


### The 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet is the Last Trump

But in the days of the voice of the **seventh angel**, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

And the **seventh angel sounded**; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

So now we come to this question. Might this Last Trumpet sound be the one rehearsed and featured by our Jewish friends at the final Neilah service on Yom Kippur? Will it be the great long Tekia Gedolah? After all, this is the last of the four classic shofar blasts. And on top of that, the spirit of climax and closure we hear in the great Tekia Gedolah does match that sense of finality we might expect to hear in the *Last Trump*. Let's listen.

So as we can tell, the great long *Tekia Gedolah* is quite different from the broken staccato trumpet blast of alarm we hear in the *Teruah*. The shouting and the blowing of multiple trumpets by men and women all over the world will break out dramatically on a future Yom **Teruah**. But that single long unbroken trumpet blast is quite a different sound. Will the Last Trump sounded by an angel at the end of the age be the great long drawn-out Tekia Gedolah?



When the verdicts of *Judgment Day* have been handed down the Last Trumpet will sound. And when the sun sets on that final Day of Accounting space-time will be unzipped. The heavens will roll back for the unveiling or Apocalypse of Messiah in the Day of the Lord. And right inside the Day of the Lord will come the execution of the Judgment by the angels of the Harvest. Dan. 9:27

The Final 7 Years of This Age

Ah yes. The dreaded Day of the Lord; and The Harvest! Let's talk about that.




The Harvest at the end of the age is spoken of throughout Holy Scripture in many ways. We hear of a harvest in which the sheaves are reaped and brought in.



The sheaves were also featured in Joseph's dream. He dreamed of the sheaves of his brothers all bowing down to his sheave.



That dream caused his brothers such anger that they sought to kill him. Apparently the House and gate of Joseph has a prominent part to play in the *end-time harvest* of the wheat. But that's another story for another time.



Another description of the end-time harvest come from the words of Jesus in His parable of the *dragnet*. Many fish are caught in the net and brought in from the sea. The first job of the fishermen is to pluck out the bad fish and throw them away. Jesus tells us very plainly that this is how it is going to be at the harvest at the end of the age.



This same theme of *the dragnet* was picked up and featured on a popular TV series back in the 60's. Los Angeles police sergeant Joe Friday was the man who was coming around. And yes, he was sifting through everyone he saw in his net. Was he out to identify and collar the good people? No, he was not. He was out to identify, pluck out, and put away the **BAD** people.





In the parable of the wheat and the tares We see a similar story. The tares, the wicked, are plucked up first. Here we are given some very valuable information as to what will happen after the judgment. The judgment will be executed in the harvest at the end of the age.

## TARES Look IDENTICAL To WHEAT



WHEAT: before it is fully ripe.

TARES: Lolium Temulentum

In Matthew 13:36-42 Jesus states quite categorically that the angels of the harvest would be loosed at the end of world. In the Greek it is end of the "eon", or in other words the end of the age. You can pause the video here and read what He said.



### Matthew 13:36-42

"Then Jesus sent the multitude away, . . . and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field. He answered and said unto them,

He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world. The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth."

In both of these harvest parables we see the same pattern and course of events. People at the end of the age are gathered together, tested by various trials, and then judged. Then in the harvest the wicked are dealt with first. The wicked are plucked up, dispatched, and carried away to a place of death.

Step 1 *Judgment*:
Condemnation

Step 2 *Execution*: The Wicked Dispatched





In the Olivet Discourse Jesus speaks of this initial rapture event, the rapture or plucking up of the wicked. He tells of two men working in the field and two women grinding grain in the mill. One is taken, the other left.




Luke 17: 34-37
One shall be taken;
The other left.

<sup>34</sup> I tell you, in that night there shall be two men in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left. <sup>35</sup> Two women shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left. <sup>36</sup> Two men shall be in the field; the *one shall be taken, and the other left*.

Who is taken? Is it the righteous or the wicked? The late Dr. John Walvoord of Dallas Theological Seminary, the recognized dean of the Pre-Trib Rapture doctrine, states that the ones taken first are the wicked. They are taken off and killed. This is just the opposite of what is taught in the "Left Behind" books.

The longtime No. 1 pretrib rapture authority, Dr. John Walvoord of Dallas Seminary, has written that the "Left Behind" books and movies have a NON-**BIBLICAL** foundation! Walvoord says in his book "The Rapture Question," p. 169, that the ones "taken" first in Matt. 24 are the wicked who are judged and killed, and the ones "left" behind are the righteous - which is just the OPPOSITE of what "Left Behind" books and films portray!



The words of Jesus confirm the truth of what Dr. Walvoord states. In the Olivet Discourse Jesus's disciples ask Him where these people will be carried off to. The place Jesus tells them about is absolutely horrific.



Jesus says it is a place where eagles and other raptors gather, a place where birds of prey gather around carcasses to pluck off the flesh. This is definitely not the rapture event we should be hoping for.




Luke 17: 34-37
One shall be taken;
The other left.

And they answered and said unto him, Where, Lord? And he said unto them, Wheresoever the body is, thither will the eagles be gathered together.

He says where the carcasses are the eagles, or some translations say vultures, will gather, presumably to eat the prey. So the wicked are taken off to a place where raptors gather to pluck off the flesh. So this first catching away is in fact a rapture of the wicked. It is definitely not the blessed hope, the glorious Resurrection-Rapture of the Elect.



In that wonderful comforting Psalm of protection, Psalm 91, King David under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit makes an interesting statement. David says "You will see the reward of the wicked." Could this passage have an application for the Harvest? Was David alluding to the protection God will afford His saints in the Day of the Lord when the wrath of God falls personally and specifically upon the wicked?



<sup>7</sup> A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. 9 Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; <sup>10</sup> There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. <sup>11</sup> For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

When the sun sets on the Last Day of this age the Day of the Lord will open up and the angels of the harvest will go out to execute the Judgment. In Matthew 13:30 Jesus tells us quite plainly that the tares will be gathered first.

Like the weeds, the tares, the rebels, the supplanters, and the usurpers who presume to live and lord over the field belonging to the Master will be bundled up and carried off to be burned in the fires. And so there should be no argument about this at all. If Jesus tells us that terrible harvest of the wicked will come first then that is precisely what is going to happen.



We read of evil angels in Psalm 78. The angels of death passed over Egypt during that first Passover and struck down the firstborn of Egypt. These are the sort of angels that will be loosed for the harvest of the wicked. This is not spoken about in our churches or synagogues. But the artists, as usual, have picked up on this theme, portraying quite faithfully and graphically the awful destiny of the wicked.



Bible prophecy teachers never speak of the Rapture of the wicked. But Jesus did. And the evil angels loosed at the harvest will not be like the cutesy ones sold in the Christian bookstore. The angels of wrath will be hideous messengers of sheer horror. The wicked will be carried off kicking and screaming. Rebels will be bundled up for the fires. As usual, the artists have been the first to pick up on this dramatic apocalyptic event. Churchmen have either lost the plot or they are reluctant to talk about it. But profane artists in the tattoo parlors have been very graphic in portraying the sheer horror of this terrible end-time harvest. The grim reapers are keen to go out and gather up THEIR people! Should we not then warn the spiritually careless of this coming horror? Dear people. If you are not saved do not neglect the call of God on your life. Today is the day of salvation!



Those who are in Christ are justified before Him. The righteous have a far brighter future. After the Judgment at the Last Day, whether dead or alive, they are caught up in the glorious Resurrection-Rapture.

Judgment: Execution: The Pardoning Resurrection-Rapture




In 1Corinthians 15:51 we see that this magnificent and unprecedented Resurrection-Rapture will be heralded by the Last Trump. In the Day of the Lord at a time unknown they are caught up. They are changed in the twinkling of an eye. They are clothed with new spiritual bodies that will last for eternity.





## 1 Corinthians 15:51-52 (KJV) 51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the *last trump*: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

There is a Blessed Hope. After the Judgment, that last and final Day of Atonement, the saved will be caught up to meet Messiah as He returns. From 1Thes. 4 we see this includes both the living and the dead. The dead are raised first, then the living. We should always speak of a **Resurrection-Rapture** and not just a bare Rapture. Back in the 19<sup>th</sup> century Religious elites divided the Rapture of the living from the Resurrection of the righteous dead. God put them together in Holy Scripture. And so what God has joined together let no man put asunder. But they got us to talk about just a bare Rapture. These men were either deceived themselves or deliberately obfuscating the truth in order to promote a popular but flawed eschatology.





## 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17 (KJV)

which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent, (or precede), them which are asleep, (have died). For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and *the dead in Christ shall rise first:* Then *we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them* in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Because the harpazo event, the Resurrection-Rapture also crossreferences with that inspiring vision of the resurrection and restoration of the whole House of Israel. This was seen by the prophet Ezekiel and described in Ezekiel 37. Ezekiel saw the entire House of Israel being raised back to life out of the Valley of Dry Bones.




And in the Olivet Discourse Jesus said that His holy angels will gather His entire undivided Elect from the four winds of heaven. This would mean His Elect would be caught up from across space and time, the living and the dead, from across this world and from both sides of Calvary.





## The Olivet Discourse Matthew 24:29-32

31 And he shall send his angels with a *great sound of a trumpet*, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

So even in a future time of severe trial our God has outlined a very positive plan. The blowing of the trumpets on **Yom Teruah**, the **Feast of** *Trumpets*, is a very necessary awakening alarm. With it comes a summons to assemble before God, and Him alone. This is outlined very clearly in *Joel chapter 2*. The ultimate days of awe are up there in our future. They will be characterized by an unprecedented *call to repentance* and end gloriously with a magnificent *End-Time Revival*.

But some may ask, "Are we as Western Christians really in need of repentance and restoration in God? Where are we falling short of the mark?" After all, we have our own personal ticket to heaven. Isn't that enough?

## ADMIT ONES Your Ticket To HEAVEN

Well we may well have our personal ticket to heaven. But we are part of a grand company. God is calling us to come up to a higher blood covenant level of responsibility. Through a process of sanctification our great salvation will blossom into its ultimate fullness in His glory. The virtue of this process of sanctification and refinement of spirit and character is not yet appreciated by Western Christian believers. But we have a sacred destiny more wonderful than we know. We have been asked to finish the race of *Hebrews 12:1*. The overcomers will run this race on behalf of all the saints who have run before them. This final leg of the relay race is our high calling. Shall we prepare ourselves to run?

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily besets *us*, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,



looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. - Heb. 12:1-2

We are in a war, a spiritual war. It is an information war, an epic battle for the souls of men. God has laid the lines for us very beautifully in the Fall **Feasts**. And since we are His witnesses to the ends of the earth we have been written into the story. But has the Western Church been readied for this? In the legend Rip Van Winkle slept through the revolution. He missed his chance to be a part of a glorious campaign. It seems that many of us are about to act out the very same story. God's covenant people are asleep.



But God loves us. He loves us enough to lay out His agenda quite accurately for us. Think of it! He has given us a roadmap and a very precise timeline for the final seven years of this age.





But nevertheless, at the end of the story, the Holy One of Israel will have His overcomers. And His end-time witness will go out to the ends of the earth.

<sup>28</sup> And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: <sup>29</sup> And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit. - Joel 2:28-29 (KJV)

Joel saw this blow-out latter rain downpour after the Great Tribulation during the 6th seal and accompanied by the cosmic signs of a darkened sun, a bloody moon, and meteor showers like stars falling. The Holy Spirit outpouring will come to a peak as Messiah returns at the end of this age.

<sup>31</sup> The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the LORD come. <sup>32</sup> And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: Joel 2:31-32

So yes, there will be a true and genuine Latter Rain outpouring. And for those who have decided to follow Jesus, come what may, the promised End-time Revival will surely come.
